SU CLINICA COVID-19 VACCINATION PARTNERSHIP

MolinaCares and MHT partnered with Su Clinica to host four COVID-19 vaccine clinics for Brownsville residents. Through these clinics, over 1,000 local residents received a COVID-19 vaccine, in addition to education and resources that allowed them to make informed health decisions.

“Partnerships are essential in reaching vulnerable and high-risk communities, and our collaboration with Molina made a tremendous difference as we worked to provide education to help residents feel informed, prepared, and ultimately comfortable receiving the vaccine,” said Dr. C.T. Reddy, chief medical officer for Su Clinica. “This partnership is part of Molina Healthcare and Su Clinica’s efforts to help get as many Rio Grande Valley residents vaccinated as possible.”



MOLINACARES AND DALLAS MUSEUM OF ART LAUNCH VIRTUAL ART CLASS SERIES FOR SENIORS


MolinaCares partnered with the Dallas Museum of Art to launch a virtual art class series, “The Artist Within,” to support Molina’s nursing facility residents during the pandemic. “The Artist Within” art classes allowed seniors who may be experiencing isolation due to the COVID-19 restrictions the opportunity to interact and engage with each other in a safe, yet fulfilling way. Participating facilities included Landmark of Plano, Midlothian Healthcare Center, Founders Plaza Nursing and Rehabilitation, and Willow Bend Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.

“The Dallas Museum of Art works to make art accessible to all, especially during a time when high-risk populations are struggling with isolation,” said Emily Wiskera, manager of access programs at the Dallas Museum of Art. “Our partnership with Molina will help us expand our engagement with vulnerable communities and spread the joy of art.”
